



Joe DiShanni Business of Year Award Selection Procedure

Eligibility Requirements

- The business selected must be a current year recipient of a Business of the Month award.
- The business must be in good standing as a member of the Irwindale Chamber of Commerce.

Selection Procedure

The Nomination Committee consists of the following:

Irwindale Chamber of Commerce Executive Board
Irwindale Chamber of Commerce Business Development Committee
Irwindale Chamber of Commerce President / CEO

The nomination committee will follow the following steps in the selections process:

1. A ballot will be created which list the twelve businesses of the month candidates.
2. Each committee member receives a copy of the original business of the month nomination form for each of the twelve Businesses of the Month recipients.
3. The committee will be charged to ensure that the business is in good standing as a member of the Irwindale Chamber of Commerce.
4. The committee will review each nomination form and base their selection on the following:
 - a. Leadership in the community
 - b. Dedication to community services
 - c. Does the company represent the philosophy, vision, mission and goals of the Irwindale Chamber of Commerce?
 - d. Involvement and support to the Irwindale Chamber of Commerce.
 - e. All around contributions to Irwindale and surrounding communities.
5. Each committee member will receive a ballot to cast his or her vote.
6. The Business Development Committee Chair and Irwindale Chamber of Commerce President/CEO will verify the votes and results of the committee.
7. The company with the most committee votes is selected.
8. In case of a tie the committee will cast a second round vote of the tied candidates only.
9. The Chair of the Board for the Irwindale Chamber of Commerce (or appointee) will notify the selected honoree and the nominator.
10. The Chair (or appointee) will notify the nominees not selected and their nominators (if applicable).
11. The award will be presented at the annual Installation Dinner in January.
